

Once again PEF has paid the registration fees for all LBPSB teams for the Montreal Regional Science & TechnologyFair March 29-31, 2015 at Concordia University

For the first time, PEF has gone beyond funding classroom projects and assisting individual students to enabling the expansion and long-term financial viability of an entire permanent **program**. The CFER at LCCHS, which had been recycling wood skids into fire kindling, had an opportunity to expand into

rebuilding and reselling actual wood skids. PEF purchased the reconditioned fork lift without which the CFER could not go forward.
